BEAUTIFUL DAY


April 16 & 17, shifts from 8:00-12:00 PM and 1:00-5:00 PM

Hebrews—Week 5 Jesus is Greater

QUESTION 1:

What does *rest* mean to you? What does it look like or sound like? Is it a place or an activity or specific people?

QUESTION 2:

How rested have you felt in the last month or so? And what situations, circumstances, or habits have most factored into how rested (or *not* rested) you feel today?

QUESTION 3:

Read **Hebrews 4:9-11**. What stands out to you? Does anything in this passage encourage or challenge you personally?

QUESTION 4:

Read the following passages regarding *rest*. Spend some time discussing the unique characteristics and particulars of how *rest* in God is found and experienced in these passages. Also talk about how you've personally experienced rest in similar ways in your own life.

Exodus 33:12-14 Matthew 11:28-30 Psalm 127:1-2

QUESTION 5:

Hand out a small piece of paper and a pen to everyone. Spend some time on your own writing down all of the big upcoming things on your to-do list. You can write down stuff that's coming up this week, this month, or even later this year. Just write down everything major that you need to get done. You can choose to write your name on your paper or keep it anonymous. It's up to you. After everyone's written some things down, fold up your pieces of paper and trade them around with other people in your group. After everyone's traded a few pieces of paper around, spend some time reading and praying for the list of things you ended up with. Pray that in the midst of all the things that need to get done, this person who wrote down this list would find the time and have the discipline to regularly enter into the rest that God offers.
