Three years ago, we launched our first church plant through our young adults ministry (Awakening), which left a gap in our ministry for 18-28 year olds. I was asked by WestGate to begin thinking about launching a ministry for young adults. I was nervous and had no idea what I was doing, so I started asking questions and seeking the advice of people who had led in similar areas. I was heartbroken as I learned how often churches don't invest in this age group, but I was excited about what God may create here at WestGate.

After 9 months of prayer, conversations, and questions, L2 was launched. We chose this name to call us back to the heart of WestGate and the heart of our mission - to Love Jesus and Live Jesus. The ministry began in my backyard with about 20 people, and now we meet in the Theater with over 120 people per week who desire to grow closer to God and to one another. It's so exciting to be a part of what God is doing, and I want to ask that you join us in reaching this generation. Here are two ways to be involved:

1) If you are age 18-28, come check us out. We meet Thursday nights from 7-9 PM at the Saratoga Campus. Come to be part of more than a gathering, come to be part of a community.

2) Pray, pray, pray. Please be praying for this ministry and this age group. There are over 150,000 people of this age range in San Jose and some estimate only about 2% of this age are involved in Church. Pray that God will stir hearts to Him.

Love, Love, Love Becoming More

QUESTION 1:

Who first shared the Good News of God's kingdom with you? What was or was not effective about their approach, as far as you can remember?

QUESTION 2:

The writer Philip Yancey once wrote, It makes all the difference in the world whether I view my neighbor as a potential convert or as someone whom God already loves. How do you generally view the people in your life who do not yet know Christ, as potential converts or as someone God already loves? How is this view manifested in your approach to these people in your everyday life?

QUESTION 3:

Read **2 Corinthians 5:14-21** out loud together. What specific parts of this passage most encourage you when it comes sharing your faith with others? What specific parts challenge you the most? And what practical takeaways do you see in this passage when it comes to sharing your faith?

QUESTION 4:

God doesn't ask us to be *successful*. He simply asks us to be a *faithful*. How does this shift in mindset specifically challenge us when it comes to sharing with others about our relationship with Christ?

QUESTION 5:

Can you identify any particular fears or anxieties that keep you from engaging in spiritual conversations with the people in your life who don't know Christ? Spend some time sharing these fears/anxieties and allow the group to share encouragement and best practices with each other.
